The Coach Development Programme offers a wide range of coaching experiences within Active Stirling provision in schools, clubs and the community and aims to enhance students' employability when graduating University.

It supports and trains individuals to develop coaching skills, coaching qualifications, consider a personal coaching pathway and to gain knowledge and experience within many specific areas of Sports Development and Active Schools. It also offers benefits such as CV building, mock interview training, event management, active learning, training and access to courses/qualifications, volunteering and the possibility of paid employment as an Active Stirling Coach.

The programme is a collaborative initiative between Active Stirling, the Sports Studies Department and the Career Development Centre at the University of Stirling.

Who can apply?

The programme is open to 2nd year students at the University of Stirling.

We would also accept applications from 1st year students however priorities would be made to 2nd year students if necessary. Nevertheless if 1st students are successful within application stages they will be automatically added to next years' programme.
